MISSIONS SPOTLIGHT

Eric Rose is excited by what he sees God doing through the work of GAiN and the Jesus Film Church Planting Strategy. They have several church planting teams in Sierra Leone and Liberia who have taken on the task of bringing the gospel to groups of people who have been known to be very difficult to reach. Four of these teams are working to plant churches among people groups who have never had a church or even really been exposed to the gospel.

Among one of these tribes, the Mano, there has been great curiosity concerning Jesus. Crowds of up to 2500 people, basically the whole village, have come to hear about Jesus, and many people have responded to the gospel!

Follow- up continues to be a challenge in terms of building these new believers into a church so please pray specifically for the Mano people of Liberia.

Some really practical items to pray about are:

1. Prayer would be appreciated for the physical safety of our teams as they work with people who are opposed to the gospel.

- 2. Pray also for the teams as they travel by motorbike on really bad roads!3. Continue to pray for open hearts to hear and understand the gospel when
- the Jesus film is presented in their own language.

4. Prayer for the follow up of these young Christians is very important. It is crucial that they be grounded in their new faith in the Lord!
