MISSIONS SPOTLIGHT

Somdy Jusse is both amazed and grateful to the Lord for the ways he sees the Lord working in the hearts of people in Thailand. Word of Somdy's ministry reached a group of Hmong believers who live in a remote jungle area in a nearby country. In the past few months, two groups, representing several communities, have come to Somdy for training. On May 5th, one of their leaders baptized 10 people! In addition to this, another leader from a different ethnic group in that country is thinking of sending a group for training. This is indeed exciting!

Somdy is hoping to work with a Christian family in the Long Khwai centre. While there are some believers already there, they aren't active in the Church. Somdy's desire is to see disciples actively making more disciples.

As we know, when the Gospel is advancing, Satan becomes more active with opposition. An example of this is that a new group had started attending Bible Studies in the township of Kut Bong. However they have succumbed to pressure from family members and are no longer participating.
